Old-Fashioned Potluck

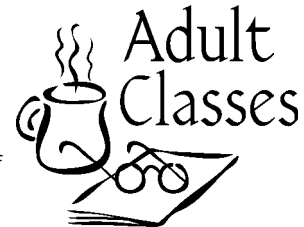
