### Summer 11<sup>th</sup> Hour Workshops

Join us this summer for *Special 11th Hour studies*. They include:

#### June 23 – Greek for the Rest of Us

This study will introduce you to the Greek language and how to use two online tools. You will learn the Greek alphabet, walk through John 3:16, and learn how to use an interlinear New Testament. For those who might want to learn more, a study plan through the book, *Greek for the Rest of Us*, by Bill Mounce, will be distributed.

#### July 28 – Discovery Bible Study

Discovery Bible Study, or DBS, is a study method that relies on the Bible itself, rather than the leader, to do the heavy lifting of discipleship. On the surface, DBS is simply reading a Bible passage and responding with a series of questions. Going deeper, DBS is a blueprint for house churches, teaching people to apply and share what they learn from the Bible. In this workshop you learn the basics. A suggested outline of 26 of the most prominent passages will be distributed with a few Do's and Don'ts.

#### August 25 – Roman Catholicism

The Roman Catholic Church is the largest Christian religion in the world. This study will examine its roots and summarize its history. Attention will be given to the authority of the church, the place of tradition, prayer to the saints, purgatory, confession, and the role of Mary. We will also attempt to chart when and how distinctive practices entered the church and how those practices have redefined the church both in America and around the world.
